She also recently filed a case in the U.S. Central District Court on behalf of Avery Dennison Corp. seeking declaratory judgment of noninfringement against PC Acquisition Inc.

Pretrial Ritual: Have another discussion with the client about settlement because you want to make sure the adrenaline of preparing for battle isn't overshadowing a chance for resolution in the client's best interest.

Biggest Career Break: One memorable experience was being included by Irell colleague David Nimmer on the U.S. Supreme Court brief for the successful petitioner Dastar Corp. against 20th Century Fox Film Corp. The case defined a company's right to be identified as producer of works whose copyrights are in public domain.
